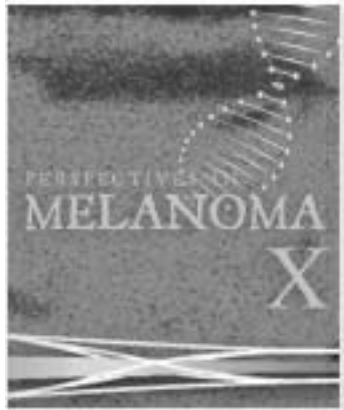
Funding for Research 2006
